  - a. Budget-This year's allotment Trust Lands/Rollover from last year
    - *i. Total available:* \$178,512.22
    - ii. Carry over from last year (2019-2020) \$29,495.35
    - iii. This year's allotment \$149,016.87
    - iv. Five areas of expenses
      - 1. Professional Development \$62,840.00
      - 2. Academic Support \$50,750.00
      - 3. Student Enrichment \$7,500.00
      - 4. School Climate \$2,000.00
      - 5. Technology \$26,000.00
  - b. TSSA Plan

- i. Budget: \$273,460.84
  - 1. Salaries \$170,000 (mostly extended periods for online teachers)
  - 2. Benefits \$55,000
  - 3. Technology \$4,000
  - 4. Supplies and Materials \$44,000
- ii. Goal: 1% growth on assessments in English, Math, and Science
- iii. Requires that the school has an Instructional Coach
- iv. Working on getting some teachers ESL endorsed
- v. Two 17-hour aides who help students with their academic progress
- vi. School-based initiatives (one-to-one Chromebooks, reduce class sizes, supplement enrichment programs, technology, teacher stipends)
- vii. Emergency kits for classrooms
- c. Tech Update One to one initiative Parent feedback
  - i. We only have about 20 extra Chromebooks right now, we are waiting for an order of 100 to come (they were ordered in February)
