c. RISE Testing Results

- i. Where are we compared to the district? Reviewed slides. In many areas we are in the top 5 of all middle schools in the District. As a whole, we are doing better than the District averages.
- ii. Did we meet our goals? Our goal was to raise test scores by at least 2%. In ELA we had an increase of 4.9%, in Math an increase of 10.6%, and in Science an increase of 3.2%.
